The Surgical Technology Program

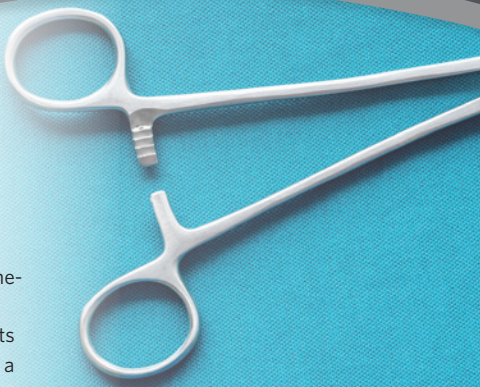
