# Baltimore City Community College Physical Therapist Assistant Program Selection Process

The application for those students who meet the prerequisites for eligibility for admission is ranked by the number of selection points he/she receives in descending order until all the seats are filled.

**Selection Process**: All applications are received by the Admissions Coordinator for the School of Nursing and Health Professions via Canvas and are reviewed by the Admissions Committee shortly after the deadline. Applicants who meet all criteria are assigned points according to the following conditions (11 points maximum):

The top **24** candidates will be invited to an Orientation and Registration session in late June or early July. If all seats are not filled, an additional Orientation and Registration will be scheduled for additional qualified applicants (from the Waiting List).
