## The Dental Hygiene program

is a two-year, 70 credit Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree program. In the final semester, students become eligible for the National Board Examinations and the Northeast Regional Board Examinations. Both exams are required for licensure.

Working under the supervision of a licensed dentist, dental hygienists:

- Remove stains and deposits and apply preventive agents to teeth
- Perform non-surgical periodontal therapy
- Take X-rays
- Take medical and dental histories
