The goal of articulation is to support transfer student success by:

- Collaborate with the Student Success Center to ensure problem-free student transfer from one institution to another.
- Provide transfer students being served by the Student Success Center with access to a baccalaureate degree granting institution by facilitating a seamless transition for students and course credits toward degree completion.
- Provide accurate information on a timely basis to the Student Success Center to assist students in planning for transfer.
- Keep communication channels open among Baltimore City Community College and other academic institutions.
- Collaborate with the Student Success Center to resolve transfer credit problems.
- Coordinate program and course articulation between Baltimore City Community College, the Baltimore City Public School System, the University System of Maryland colleges, and independent and out-of-state institutions.
- Provide leadership for the development and implementation of articulation agreements that support and further develop transfer and articulation activities.
- Provide technical assistance to academic departments and the Student Success Center in the areas of articulation.
- Serve as liaison with BCCC Student Success Center counselors/advisors, the community, Business Continuing Education Division (BCED), and colleges/universities to support the development of articulation agreements and transfer resources.
- Serve as a resource to faculty in the development of curriculum regarding articulation of courses and transfer resolution.
- Keep abreast of proposed BCCC curriculum changes and state-wide articulation issues and activities.
- Interpret the impact of curricular changes of other institutions' requirements for transfer students by attending campus, regional, transfer/ student services events and statewide meetings.
