Memorandum of Understanding Honors Student Transfer Baltimore City Community College and Goucher College

PURPOSE

This agreement between Baltimore City Community College (BCCC) and Goucher College recognizes the outstanding academic achievement of BCCC Honors students and seeks to provide for a seamless and successful transition for students who meet BCCC's Honors requirements to Goucher College.

CRITERIA

Transfer students from BCCC who meet BCCC's Honors requirement and who meet the minimum GPA of 3.5 are guaranteed admission into Goucher College during the Fall Semester or the Spring Semester provided the student has met the following criteria:

- Has applied to Goucher College
- Has met or is in the process of completing all the requirements for the AA, AS, or AAT degree or a minimum of 60 undergraduate credits from BCCC
 - o Confirmation required from Registrar's Office
- Has earned at least a 3.5 cumulative GPA at the time of application to Goucher College

OTHER PROVISIONS

- Students meeting the above criteria will:
 - o Be able to apply to Goucher college with the application fee waived,
 - o Be considered for a transfer merit scholarship up to \$19,000 as well as other scholarships for which the student is eligible, and
 - o Receive an additional \$2,000 scholarship if a member of Phi Theta Kappa.
- BCCC and Goucher College will collaborate to promote Goucher College's scholarship program for BCCC honors students.
- Both institutions agree to communicate annually to share information on curricular and program changes as well as all processes relative to this agreement.
- Nothing in this agreement should be construed to prevent and/or inhibit reverse transfer of Goucher College credits to BCCC.
- This agreement shall become effective upon the signing of both parties and shall continue in
 effect until both parties agree in writing to modify or terminate the agreement. Termination of
 the agreement shall become effective ninety (90) days after written notice is given.
