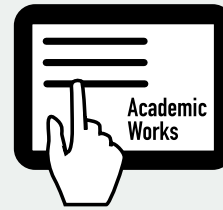

1. Go to bccc.academicworks.com
2. Review the available scholarships opportunities
3. Create a new account or login to an existing account
4. Submit a General Application
**Must submit a new application each semester*
5. Select which scholarship you wish to apply for
**Note: You will automatically be considered for other opportunities*
6. Complete FASFA and/or Income Verification Form*

HOW TO ACCEPT AN AWARDED SCHOLARSHIP

1. You will be notified via email that you were awarded a scholarship
2. Login to your AcademicWorks account
3. Accept your scholarship
4. Submit Thank You Letter to scholarship donor
**Note: Scholarship will not be disbursed to Financial Aid if Thank You Letter is not submitted.*

AFCEA CENTRAL MD CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP

Students must major in Computer Information Systems, Cyber Security and Assurance, Electrical Engineering, Engineering Transfer, Robotics/ Mechanics Technology, or Arts and Sciences Transfer-Mathematics Option.

AKA, RHO XI OMEGA CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP

Students must be a Maryland resident, a U.S. Citizen, and demonstrate financial need.

ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

Student must verify participation in community service or extracurricular activity. Awardees maintaining a 2.5 GPA in first semester of award also are awarded second semester.

ANCIENT BALTIMORE FOUNDATION

Student must be enrolled full-time at BCCC, a Baltimore City resident and have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5.

ARNOLD & VIRGIE WILLIAMS SCHOLARSHIP

Open to full-time credit students only. Scholarship may only be applied to tuition.

BCCCF SCHOLARSHIP

Student must be a Maryland Resident, full-time student, and demonstrate financial need.

BCCCF SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP

Student must be full-time, have completed at least 30 credits at BCCC with 12 credits in Science, and enrolled in Science Transfer or Biotechnology.

BOARD DESIGNATED

Open to all international students.

COMMUNITY WIDE SCHOLARSHIP

Open to all BCCC students.

FREDERICK DOUGLASS HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF '42 BOOK SCHOLARSHIP

Students must demonstrate financial need and have graduated from Frederick Douglass High School. This award is only for books.

GENERAL BOOK SCHOLARSHIP

Open to all BCCC students.

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Students must demonstrate financial need and be a Maryland resident.

HARLOW FULLWOOD JR. FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

Student must demonstrate financial need and be a City resident.

HARVEY AND BEVERLY GOLD

Open to students majoring in Liberal Arts & Social Sciences.

HERMAN E. WESTERBERG SCHOLARSHIP

This award is for students who have not received a PELL Grant in the current semester.

HOMETOWN HEROES SCHOLARSHIP FUND

This award will provide financial support for tuition, books, fees and supplies. Students must show proof of residency in the 45th District and be registered to vote.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

Restricted to members of the International Students Club. Must provide documentation of memberships from the club advisor.

JAMES D. TSCHECHTELIN FOUNDATION WORKFORCE SCHOLARSHIP

Students must be enrolled in 6-18 credits per semester, already completed 6 credits, not receiving other financial aid, and have completed 6 credits at BCCC. Must work a minimum of 20 hours weekly and not be Pell Grant eligible. This scholarship pays 50% of the student's tuition, books and fees.

JOLLEY, BARDNEY, JACKSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Two full years of tuition, and fees to deserving students who graduated in 2016 or 2017 from Renaissance Academy. Students are required to submit one recommendation letter and write a short personal essay.

LATIN X SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is for students that are of LatinX heritage, members of LatinX UNI2 club and are not eligible for FASFA.

Scholarship covers tuition, fees, and books and is open to all majors. Requirements include: essay, video, letter of recommendation, financial verification and resume.

LIFE SCIENCES SCHOLARSHIP

Open to BCCC students majoring in Life Sciences.

Student must be a Business Major.

MICHAEL HODES ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Open to all BCCC students.

NEALL FAMILY CHARITABLE FOUNDATION

Students selected for Fall will also receive the same award in the Spring semester of the academic year.

OSBORNE A. PAYNE SCHOLARSHIP

Student must be a U.S. Citizen, Baltimore City Resident, and demonstrate financial need.

OTIS WARREN SCHOLARSHIP

Student must be a graduate of Baltimore City Public High School and complete a 500 word essay.

PEARSON LIZ KAUFMAN SCHOLARSHIP

Student must be a single mother 30 years of age with a child or dependent adult in the household, successfully completed 12 credits.

PEGGY JORDAN NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

Student must have a 3.0 GPA and be majoring in Nursing, have completed one year at BCCC and demonstrate financial need.

REGINALD F. LEWIS SCHOLARS FUND

Reginald F. Lewis High School alumni will be given first preference. Must major in business, finance, or related field and endeavor to perform 10 hours of community service.

WORKFORCE CONSTRUCTION

Open to students majoring in Construction Supervision only. Student must verify employment of at least 20 hours a week for last 6 months.

WORKFORCE SCHOLARSHIP

Students must verify employment of 20 or more hours weekly for the last 6 months.

WORKFORCE TECHNOLOGY FUND

Open to students majoring in Telecommunications or Computer Information Systems only. Student must verify employment of 20 or more hours weekly for the last 3 months.

WORKFORCE TRAINING FUND (BCYF)

Available to students applying to specific workforce training programs that lead to industry certification, direct employment, and support transition to certificate and degree completion.
