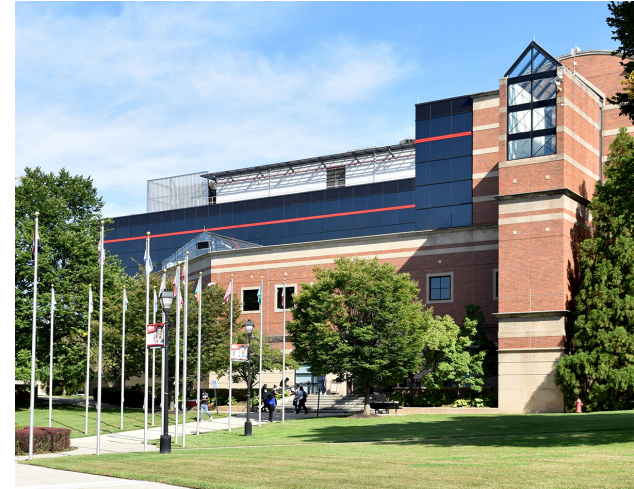

Computer Information Systems

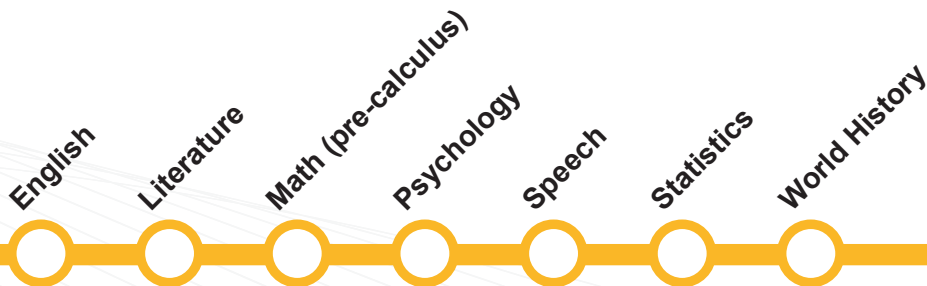


HOW YOU CAN PARTICIPATE

1. Complete an Application for Admission. Note the Application timeline and deadline dates.

3. Complete placement testing (if required) and meet with an Admissions representative to review placement test results and/or register for classes. Information will be provided.
4. Attend BCCC's mandatory Dual Enrollment Orientation Program. Information will be provided.
