



**BALTIMORE CITY COMMUNITY COLLEGE
INTERNATIONAL STUDENT
TWELVE-MONTH BUDGET**

Effective Fall 2017*

In order to be accepted as an International Student and receive a Form I-20 from Baltimore City Community College, a student must provide financial documentation that reflects the sponsor's financial willingness and ability to accept this financial burden **for the entire length of the student's program**. Financial documents must be **no older than 3 months** at the time of submission. All financial documents must be in English or officially translated to English. Bank statements must show at least **3 months of transactions, showing at least the minimum balance below at the end of each month**. The sponsor(s) must provide an affidavit, stating that they will be the sponsor of the student (sponsors residing in the USA should use Form I-134, available at www.uscis.gov/forms). The names on the bank statements must match the names on the Financial Support Statement, or affidavit. That financial burden is estimated as follows:

❖ TUITION AND FEES (\$280 per credit, 3,613 per semester for 12 credits + fees)	\$7,226.00
❖ LIVING EXPENSES	\$9,075.00
❖ OTHER (Transportation, Books, Supplies, etc.)	\$2,890.00

Minimum balance required on financial support documents (2 years of expenses)	<u>\$38,382.00</u>

English Language Instruction (English as a Second Language)

❖ TUITION AND FEES (up to \$1,860 for 18 hours/week)	\$3,720.00
❖ LIVING EXPENSES	\$9,075.00
❖ OTHER (Transportation, Books, Supplies, etc.)	\$2,890.00
TOTAL YEARLY ESTIMATED LIVING EXPENSES*	<u>\$15,685.00</u>
Minimum balance required on financial support documents (18 months of expenses)	<u>\$23,528.00</u>

- *Students who need a Form I-20 for dependents:* Please provide financial documentation with an additional \$2,000.00 for each dependent (spouses and children who will remain in the USA with the student).
- In order to maintain F-1 visa status, students **MUST be enrolled full-time** (at least 12 credits enrollment each semester for credit programs or at least 18 hours/week enrollment in the English Language Instruction classes).
