PARAMEDICINE PROGRAM Pre-Admission Fact Sheet

What are the requirements for the Paramedic and Paramedic Bridge Certificates?

A. Pre-Program Entry Requirements:

- o Students must be 18 years of age or older by the first day of class
- o Complete the College's ACCUPLACER entrance exam and receive a placement recommendation of MAT 92 or higher and exempt from developmental reading.
- o PRE 100 Preparation for Academic Achievement
- o General Biology Placement Exam – To test out, a student must score a minimum of 70% on the test; only two attempts are allowed. Failure to pass the test-out exam will require the student to register into either of the two General Biology courses, Bio 101 or Bio 102
- o BIO 107 Anatomy & Physiology - If completed successfully BIO 202/BIO 203 will substitute for BIO 107. Must complete BIO 107 or BIO 202/BIO 203 with a "C" or better. Sciences must be completed within 5 years of entry into the program.
- o Current AHA CPR Provider (Basic Life Support)
- o Certified Emergency Medical Technician (Paramedic Certificate) or
- o Licensed Cardiac Rescue Technician (Paramedic Bridge Certificate)
- o Complete the Computer Literacy Requirement

Note: Effective in the Fall 2016, Paramedic Bridge applicants will be required to take a Cardiac Rescue Technician exam.

C. Selection Process: Total possible score 15

1. Baltimore City resident Yes ____ (1) No ____ (0)
2. ACCUPLACER results:
 - a. Developmental reading not required or completed (1)
 - b. Developmental mathematics not required or completed (1)
3. PRE 100 completed with a "C" or better
4. BIO 107 completed with a "C" or better
(point value 7-10: GPA: 4.0 = 10, 3.9-3.0 = 9, 2.9-2.5 = 8, 2.4-2.0 = 7)
5. Previous College Education
 - a. College level credits earned - 31 or more credits (2)
 - b. College level credits earned - 9-30 credits (1)

Note: Students must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher in all Paramedic certificate courses.

What are the requirements for the AAS in Paramedicine Degree?

- o Completion of either the Paramedic or Paramedic Bridge Certificate
- o ENG 101: English Composition
- o SP 101: Fundamentals to Speech Communication
- o PSY 101 Introduction to Psychology
- o Mathematics Elective – Any college level math course
- o Any 2 additional General Education courses of the student's choosing
- o Must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher for all Paramedicine courses.
- o Note: Paramedic students are exempt from HLF physical education courses.
