The Emergency Medical Services program instructs students how to provide emergency medical treatment at the scene of an accident or illness and transport the injured and sick to medical facilities. The provider also analyzes and takes command of patient care with full responsibility for the patient until relieved by proper medical staff.

Endless Career Options

Successful completion of the program results in students being eligible to take State and/or National Registry examinations for certification as an Emergency Medical Technician.

An Emergency Medical Technician Refresher class is offered by the College's Business and Continuing Education Division. The class follows the current Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services System guidelines for Emergency Medical Technician Refresher.
