It is the policy of Baltimore City Community College to encourage reporting of concerns related to abuse, suspicious or improper behavior, or abuse of power or position in the administration or conduct of College athletic programs and activities so that prompt corrective action can be taken by The College.

A report by a student, given in good faith, regarding an issue or potential issue or illegal or improper activities, abuse of position or power, or illegal or immoral behavior will not be tolerated or condoned by the College. Baltimore City Community College does not tolerate harassment or retaliation in any form against persons who report.

Anyone found to have retaliated against or harassed an individual for reporting a good faith concern, will be subjected to disciplinary actions according to this policy and the BCCC Student Code of Conduct.

This policy does not protect an individual who files a report or provides information that the individual knows to be false, or provides information with reckless disregard for its truth or falsity.
