Policy Purpose:

All BCCC Students must meet the College's Computer Literacy requirement in order to receive a degree or a certificate.

Policy Statement:

It is the policy of Baltimore City Community College that students are computer literate prior to graduating with a degree or certificate. Students may satisfy the computer literacy graduation requirement by passing the computer literacy test with a minimum score of 70%. The computer literacy test may be taken a maximum of <u>two times</u>. This test is one of the four approved options to meet the computer literacy graduation requirement. Other options for students are:

- 1. Taking one of the computer courses that meet the computer literacy requirement and passing the course with a "C" or better.
- 2. Passing CLT 100 course
- 3. Transferring 15 or more credits from other higher education institutions.
