## Policy Purpose:

This policy applies to all students and prospective students who seek entry into the Dental Hygiene, Nursing, Physical Therapist Assistant, Respiratory Care, Health Information Technology, and Surgical Technology Degree programs. This policy also applies to all students who seek entry into the Emergency Medical Services Certificate program, Coding Certificate program, and the Practical Nursing Certificate program. These programs and certificates have a selective admissions process.

## **Policy Statement:**

It is the policy of Baltimore City Community College to have a selective admission process for the following programs: Dental Hygiene, Nursing, Physical Therapist Assistant, Respiratory Care, Health Information Technology, and Surgical Technologist Degree programs. This policy also applies to all students who seek entry into the Emergency Medical Services Certificate program, Coding Specialist Certificate program, and the Practical Nursing Certificate programs. Students who have completed the prerequisite courses must apply to the program. Each application is reviewed and ranked based on specific criteria.
