This policy is to established compliance with the reasonable accommodation requirements and the ADA Amendments Act.

Background to Issue/Rationale for Policy:

Baltimore City Community College is committed to the fair and equal employment of people with disabilities.

Policy Language:

It is the policy of Baltimore City Community College to provide disabled job candidates and employees who meet the job requirements of the position, with reasonable accommodations, as required by the Americans with Disability Act (ADA) as amended. Disability is defined as a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more of the major life activities of an individual. Only individuals who have a documented disability, or are regarded as having such, are entitled to reasonable accommodations.
