Background to Issue/Rationale for Policy:

A student is recommended each year as a voting member of the College's Board of Trustees. This policy details the requirements for an eligible student.

State/Federal Regulatory Requirements (cite if applicable):

The Board of Trustees exercises general control over the College and establishes broad policy and long-range planning to effect the efficient operation of the College.

In addition to the other powers granted and duties imposed by State laws and regulations, and subject to the authority of the Maryland Higher Education Commission, the Board of Trustees has the powers and duties set forth in §16-505 of the Education Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended.

Policy Language:

It is the policy of Baltimore City Community College to accept applications for the position of Student Representative to the Board of Trustees. The student must be at least 18 years old, have integrity, possess an overall GPA of 3.0 or better, be currently enrolled full-time, have completed at least 12 credits. The term for the student trustee is one year starting July 1st and ending June 30th.
