Topic/Issue:

Baltimore City Community College is committed to a drug free environment which includes illegal drugs, the misuse of prescription drugs or the use of alcohol.

Background to Issue/Rationale for Procedure:

College students frequently engage in the use and misuse of drugs and alcohol. This policy governs such behaviors on the college campus and prohibits such activity. It is the institution's responsibility to educate students of their responsibilities under this policy.

Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act Amendment of 1993 (Public Law 101-226) and the Maryland Higher Education Commission's Policies Concerning Drug and Alcohol Abuse Control.

Proposed Procedural Language:

BCCC will maintain a drug free campus. A copy of the BCCC Drug Free Policy statement will be posted on the Blackboard and included in the Student Handbook, the Student Code of Conduct and the electronic Catalog. Educational programming will provide timely and appropriate information on this topic throughout the academic year. Appropriate referrals will be made when deemed necessary.
